

Declaration

We - 26 students and 35 teachers - participants of the international Conference "PHOSPHORUS STOP", from Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Russia and Sweden, have worked 30 September to 2 October 2010 in Jūrmala, Latvia. During the conference we have been working in groups, presenting our opinion in Phosphorus stop activities and discussing about ecological problems in the countries of the Baltic Sea Region.

In view of the above, we call on the governments in the Baltic Sea Region:

- noting the eutrophication and its consequences;
- concerned about the number of people who are not connected to a cleaning system, connect them and modernize the cleaning system;
- worried about the depleting of the fish;
- therefore determined to take strong actions against the bad fishing methods through laws, protected areas etc;
- giving more interactive information and education to everyone in the Baltic Sea area;
- clean the coast of the Baltic Sea by "joint work" and volunteers;
- forbid phosphates in washing powders and liquids in all countries;
